Irish Screen Editors Ethics Charter

Introduction

The Irish Screen Editors guild is committed to fostering a positive, inclusive, and respectful environment for all members. This Ethics Charter outlines the standards of behaviour expected from every guild member. All members are required to adhere to the following principles to maintain the integrity and reputation of the guild.

1. Respect for Fellow Members

Guild members shall treat each other with respect, courtesy, and professionalism at all times and at all social occasions. Discrimination, harassment, bullying, or any form of abusive behaviour towards other members will not be tolerated.

2. Professionalism and Conduct

Each member represents the guild in their professional and personal conduct, and actions that reflect poorly on the guild will not be accepted.

3. Guild Reputation

Members shall refrain from engaging in any actions or behaviours that may potentially harm the reputation of the guild. This includes, but is not limited to, unethical conduct, criminal activities, or any conduct that will reflect adversely on the guild. The misuse of guild resources, names, or affiliations for personal gain or unethical purposes shall result in disciplinary measures.

4. Conflict Resolution

Should a conflict arise between members, it must be resolved in a manner that is fair and respectful to all parties involved.

5. Disciplinary Measures

Any member found to be in violation of this Ethics Charter may face disciplinary actions, including

warnings, suspension, or termination of membership, depending on the severity of the breach. The guild committee will investigate allegations of misconduct and ensure fair and just proceedings. All disciplinary proceedings must go to the ISE Committee and be voted on for approval.
